School Work

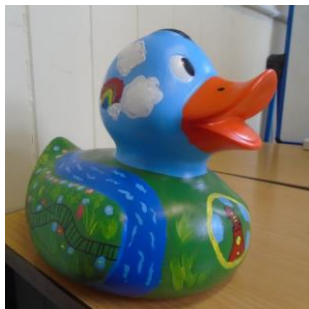
Please could everyone bring in a named carrier bag next week so that we can send home your child's work.
